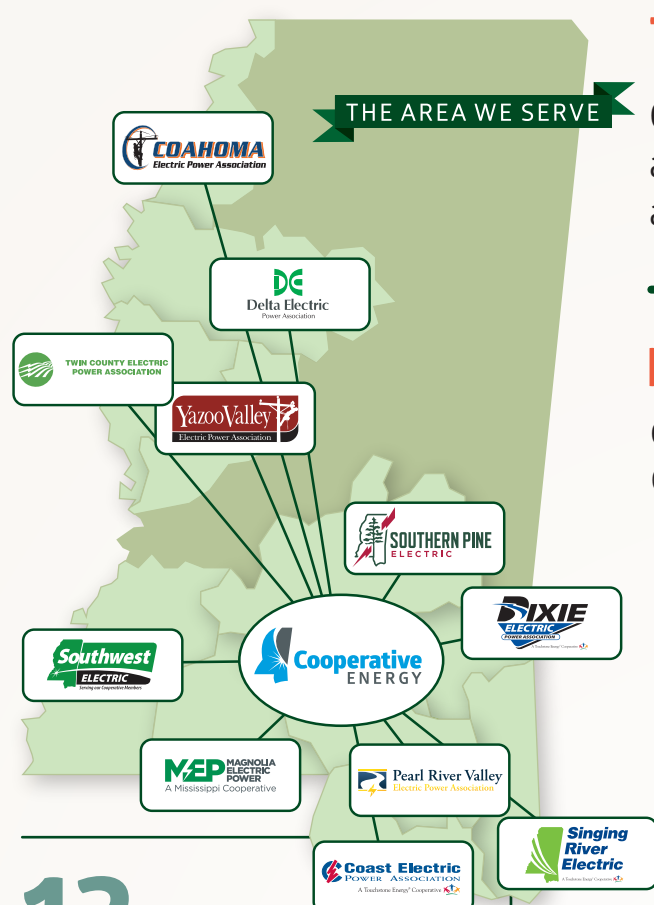

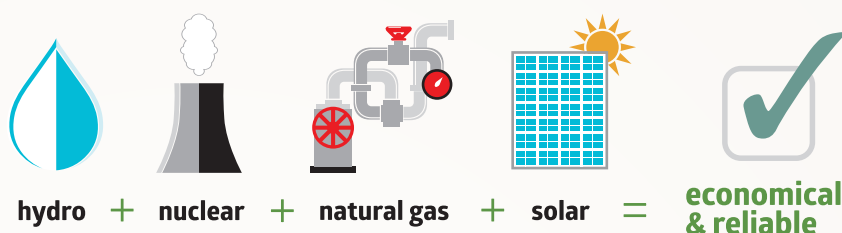
The Power of 12

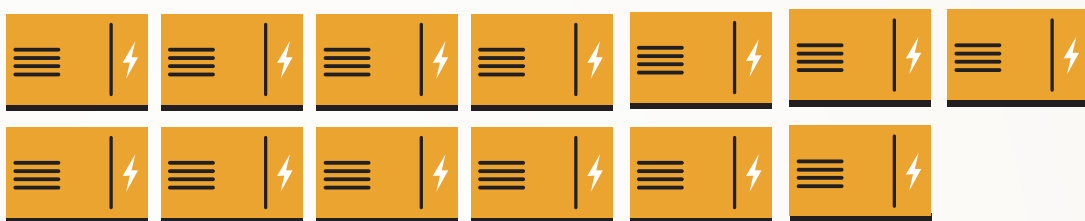
How do we get Power?

Cooperative Energy generates and transmits power to your electric cooperative.

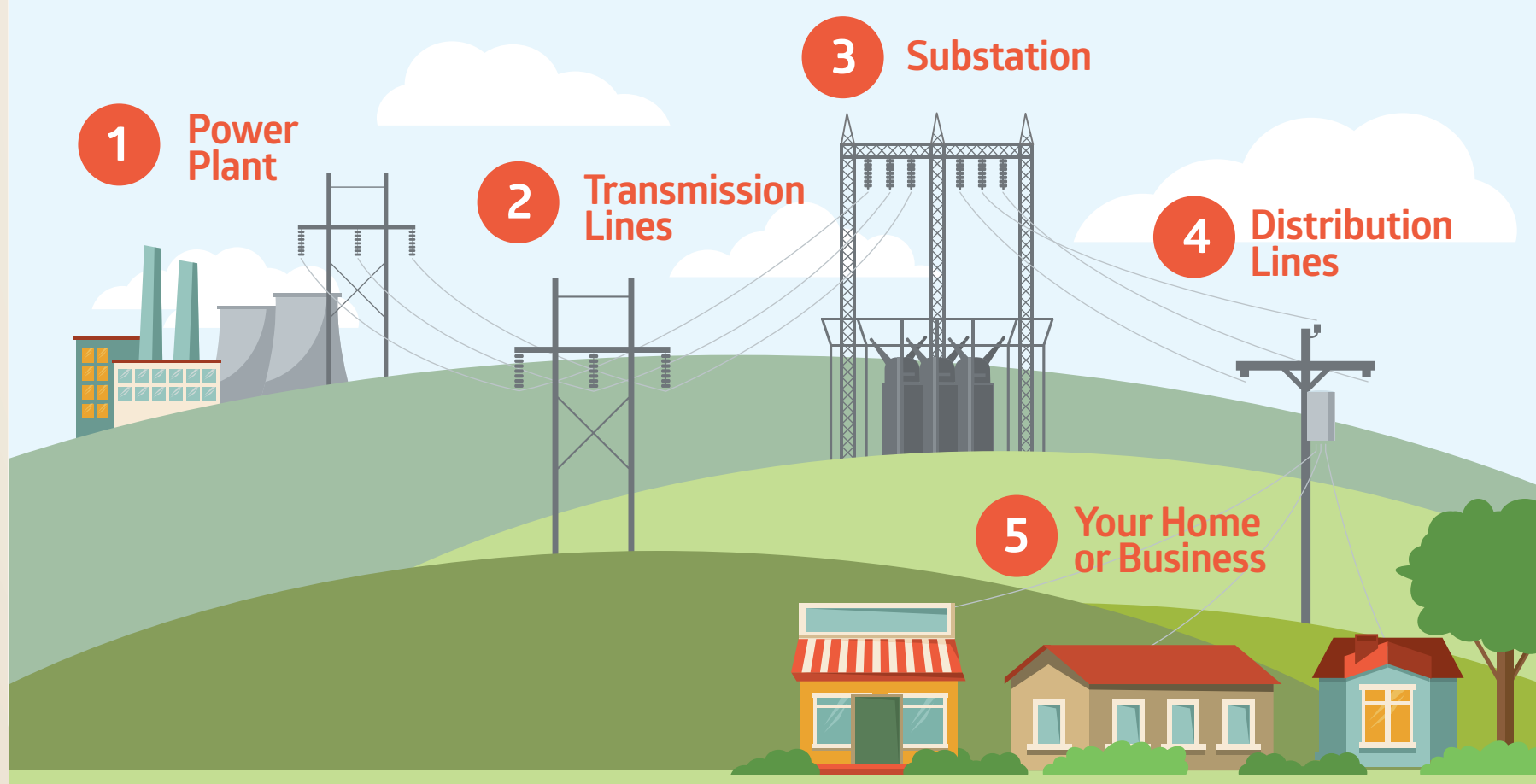


We have 13 generating units located across Mississippi.



Where Does Your Electricity Come From?

Cooperative Energy operates generating units across the state and then transmits electricity to our 11 Member cooperatives, who then distribute power to your home or business. Here's the journey from generator to meter.
