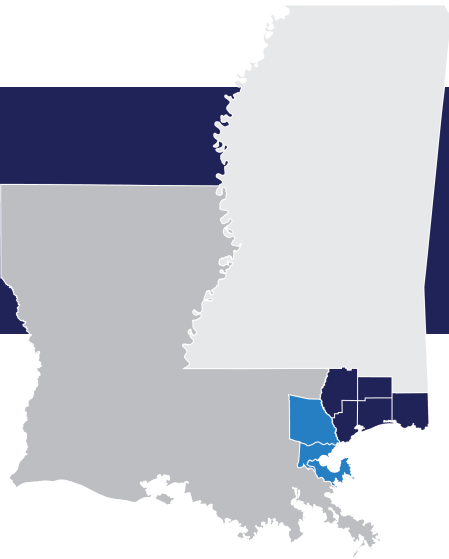

## AREA PROFILE

The Stennis International Airport 45 minute drive-time region is defined as the counties of Pearl River, Hancock, Harrison, Stone, Jackson as well as St. Tammany Parish, Orleans Parish, and St. Bernard Parish of Louisiana.

Within this region, approximately **155,084** people have monthly earnings of between **\$1,251** to **\$3,333**.

**53.2%** of the workers in this earnings bracket are between the ages of **30 and 54 years**. **25.6%** are age **29 or younger**, and **21.2%** are age **55 or older** (table 1).

Within this region and earnings bracket, 22.9% are employed in Accommodation and Food Services, 16.5% in Health Care and Social Assistance, and 14.4% in Retail Trade. The remaining industries all employ less than 10% of these workers with **3.2% employed in Manufacturing** (table 2).

## COMMUTING PATTERNS

A majority of the workers in this earnings bracket live less than 10 miles from work. **20%** live **10-24 miles** from work, and **11.1%** live **greater than 50 miles** from work (table 3).

The largest amount of workers in this earnings bracket live in the **City of New Orleans, Louisiana**, followed by the cities of Gulfport, MS, Biloxi, MS, Metairie, LA, Slidell, LA, and Kenner, LA (table 4).
