### **AREA PROFILE**

The Brookhaven Spec Building 45 minute drive-time region is defined as the counties of Adams, Franklin, Jefferson Davis, Marion, Covington, Copiah, Walthall, Claiborne, Lincoln, Rankin, Hinds, Jefferson, Lawrence, Pike, Simpson, and Amite as well as Washington Parish, Tangipahoa Paris, and St. Helena Parish of Louisiana.

Within this region, approximately **127,398** people have monthly earnings of between **\$1,251** to **\$3,333**.

**54%** of the workers in this earnings bracket are between the ages of **30 and 54 years**. **22.9%** are age **29 or younger**, and **23.1%** are age **55 or older** (table 1).

Within this region and earnings bracket, 20.1% are employed in Healthcare and Social Assistance and 14% in Retail Trade. The remaining industries all employ less than 10% of these workers with 8.2% employed in Manufacturing (table 2).

### **COMMUTING PATTERNS**


A majority of the workers in this earnings bracket live less than 10 miles from work. **24.6%** live **10-24 miles** from work, and nearly **19%** live **greater than 50 miles** from work (table 3).

The largest amount of workers in this earnings bracket live in the **City of Jackson**, followed by the cities of Pearl, Clinton, Brandon, Ridgeland, McComb, and Natchez (table 4).
