

AREA PROFILE

The Jackson County Aviation Tech Park 45 minute drive-time is defined as the counties of Greene, Stone, George, Harrison, Jackson, Mobile (AL), and Baldwin (AL).

Within this region, approximately **142,322** people have monthly earnings of between **\$1,251** to **\$3,333**.

52.6% of the workers in this earnings bracket are between the ages of **30 and 54 years**. **26.1%** are age **29 or younger**, and **21.3%** are age **55 or older** (table 1).

COMMUTING PATTERNS




